The more information you can give us, the better. 10 minutes of your time writing down your requirements and doing a simple sketch or drawing will give our designers a good idea of what you want to achieve. They will then work with this information to design eye-catching school sign designs for you to look at. Amend it, change it, compare it or even throw it in the bin..... we are happy to amend any designs until you are 100% happy with what you see. Then and only then would we ask you to sign the final proof that you are happy and place your order with us.

Nobody Likes Problems :- (

Problems !!

Like you, we work hard to avoid any problems. In the past we have found that most problems arise because we were not given the correct information in the first place. The visual element of your new signs is checked, checked and checked again by you, by our designers and by our production team but most problems arise when you receive your new signs and a beautiful 3 metre tall hedge has suddenly grown in front of where your new sign was supposed to go. A new metal Palisade fence was installed during the summer holidays. Please check for obstructions, longer posts can be supplied but we need to know about these obstructions before we dispatch your signs or we arrive on site to install them. We need to know sizes of railings for fittings, diameters of existing posts, opening times, closing times term times, tea break times :-) No matter how small if you think its relevant then please tell us.

We will supply a colour visual for you to check or amend until you are 100% happy
- Would You Like to Include any Church Logo's, Crests or Emblems ?**
Please send us the best quality images or artwork that you have available
- What Colours Would You Like Used on Your News Signs ?**
Look at our colour charts and our designers will use the colours you select on the visual
- Where and How are Your New Signs to be Fitted ?**
In Concrete ? In Grass ? Tarmac ? Flowerbed ?
- Do You Require any Additional Options Added to Your Visual ?**
Protective Face Film ? Coloured Posts ? Additional Sign Slips ? Decorative Finials ?
- Are There Any Obstructions ? ie Hedges, Fences, Railings or Walls ?**
